Chickenpox

Chickenpox is a highly contagious disease, characterised by small blisters appearing in new batches every three to four days, usually starting on the trunk but then spreading to the face, arms and legs and eventually scabbing over. Chickenpox can also be a hazard to pregnant women.

Please consult your Doctor or Midwife to confirm your own immunity status. We will display notices around the School informing you of any outbreaks of Chickenpox and if your child contracts Chickenpox, please let the School as soon as possible. Your child should be kept away from School for at least six days. If after six days, the scabs have not dropped off, your child should be kept away from School until they have.
